



Turrumurra 2008 Community Grants Program Guidelines & Application Conditions

The Program will offer grants to benefit charitable and not-for-profit organisations for the benefit of the Community.

Objectives:

The Community Grants Program is administered by Community Enterprise Foundation and made possible by the generous support of Turrumurra **Community Bank®** branch.

The Community Grants Program is designed to:

- Make better, targeted use of funds that are responsive to community needs.
- Provide a simpler application process.
- To enable us to be more responsive to the needs of communities.

What can be funded?

- Charitable and Not-for-profit Organisations can apply for projects and activities that offer clear public benefit for communities. Contributing to their development in building social capital, community welfare, environmental, health, education or cultural areas.
- Grants will be made in amounts up to \$10,000.
- To be eligible, projects must be for a charitable purpose.
- There are some funds which are restricted to Deductible Gift Recipients (DGRs). Though the greater portion of unrestricted funds are available for general charitable purposes. All applications for projects which are charitable will be received and considered.
- **Organisations should have an ABN.**

Applications must be from groups from within the Turrumurra surrounds

Currently, preference will be given to projects that support:

- families, children and youth initiatives
- public health programs and services
- community capacity building projects
- public education, including tertiary education, school building and libraries
- innovative community services
- cultural and arts initiatives, and
- environmental projects.

How to Apply

In order to apply for a grant the application form contained in this document **must** be completed. Applications for funding that are not provided in the correct form will not be accepted.

Typed applications are preferred although hand-written applications are accepted (please ensure legibility).
